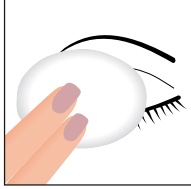
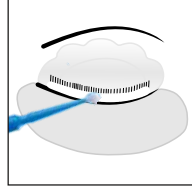


Lash Lifting EXPRESS PRO / Step by Step



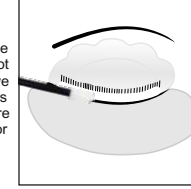
Step 1:

Clean the eyelashes carefully before you start the treatment. Remove make-up residues preferably with our Lash & Brow Cleanser or Lash Shampoo. Afterwards, use our Primer. Also clean the eyelids so that they are free of grease. This ensures optimal bonding of the Silicon Pads during the complete treatment.



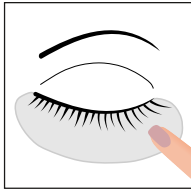
Step 6:

Now apply the Super Fast Perming Lotion Step.1 densely from the base to the center of the lashes with a suitable applicator. The tips of the lashes must not come into contact with the lotion. Always start at the outer corner of the eye and work your way to the inner corner. The exposure time is 5-8 minutes depending on the thickness of the natural eyelashes. Calculate the exposure time for each eye separately so that each eye is also treated with the lotion for the same length of time.



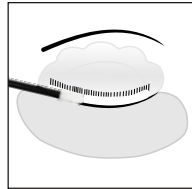
Step 9:

After the exposure time, carefully remove the lotion with a lint-free applicator. Lukewarm water can be used for this step. Please only moisten the applicator and do not make it wet. Make sure that no lotion or color residues are left on the eyelashes.



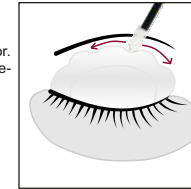
Step 2:

Place the eye pads under the eyes and cover the lower lashes. Make sure that all the lower eyelashes are under the eye pads, otherwise you will lift them up too.



Step 7:

After the exposure time, remove the lotion Step.1 with a dry lint-free applicator. Thoroughly clean off the lotion so that there are no more residues on the eyelashes and the Silicon Pads.



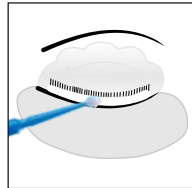
Step 10:

Carefully roll a damp microfiber stick between the silicone pad and the skin until the silicone pad comes off. Before carefully removing the silicone pad, make sure that all eyelashes are detached. The silicone pad must be removed with great care. Then remove any adhesive residue with a damp cotton pad. Brush the eyelashes well from the base to the tip with an eyelash brush.



Step 3:

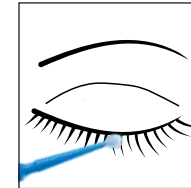
Place the silicone pads on the eyes to find the right size. To get the ideal effect, the eyelashes should lie two-thirds on the silicone pads.



Step 8: (Select an Option)

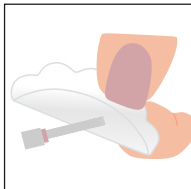
Option 1 without dyeing or dye afterwards after step 9:
Apply the Fixing & Coloring Lotion densely from the base to the center of the lashes using a suitable applicator. Leave the lotion on for 5-7 minutes depending on the thickness of the lashes.

Option 2 color and fix in one step:
Mix the Fixing & Coloring Lotion 1:1 with color. Use as much color as Lotion Step.2. Apply the mixture densely from the base to the tips of the lashes. If the lower lashes are to be colored as well, lift the eye pads that cover the lower lash line and place them under the lower lashes. The lower row of lashes can now be tinted at the same time as the upper lashes. Leave the lotion on for 8 - 10 minutes depending on the thickness of the lashes.



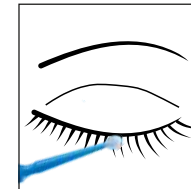
Step 11: (Optionally)

Now apply a small amount of Lash Botox 24 ct. gold thinly with a suitable applicator. Leave this on for 1-2 minutes and comb the eyelashes carefully. Without removing continue with step 12.



Step 4:

Now apply the glue to the back of the silicone pads and place it as close as possible to the lash line. Fix the pad always starting from the inner corner of the eye away to the outer corner of the eyelid. Hold the silicone pads for about 5 seconds so that the glue can dry. The pad must sit firmly and must not slip.



Step 12: (Optionally)

Then apply the keratin lamination to the lashes with a suitable applicator, let it dry for 1-2 minutes and comb the lashes again. For best results, leave on the lamination on the lashes for 12 hours. The lashes must not come into contact with water for at least 12 hours after treatment.



Step 5:

Apply the glue to the silicone pads and pull the lashes firmly and straight up with the Lifting Tool or the Y-Brush. Mentally divide the row of lashes into 3 small zones and start in the middle. Repeat the process zone by zone until all lashes stick straight to the silicone pad. Always work in small zones as the glue dries very quickly. The lashes must be pulled up tightly so that the eyelid is visible. Make sure that all the lashes are straight on the silicone pads because the way you fix the lashes on the pads is the way the result will be. If a few eyelashes need to be corrected, first moisten the eyelashes again with some glue.
